1 For the reasons stated in the Court's August 5, 2014 Order GRANTING
2 Plaintiff's Motion for Permanent Injunction and Cancellation of Trademark
3 Registrations, and based on the parties' Stipulation re: Permanent Injunction, the
4 Court hereby Orders the following:

5 NuVasive and each of its officers, agents, servants and employees, and all
6 those persons in active concert or participation with them are hereby forever
7 enjoined from using the mark NEUROVISION in the sale, offering for sale,
8 distribution, lending, marketing or advertising of medical devices or related
9 merchandise and services at any locality in the United States, provided, however,
10 that the following shall not be considered a violation of this injunction:

- 11 ○ Use of or reference to the NEUROVISION mark for
12 truthful informational purposes with investors and
13 regulatory agencies, including without limitation, the
14 Securities and Exchange Commission or FDA, to
15 refer to historic products, historic product sales,
16 and/or this lawsuit;
- 17 ○ In response to a customer inquiry, NuVasive can
18 truthfully explain that it formerly marketed products
19 under the name NEUROVISION.
