- 10 (4) On its Second Counterclaim, Defendant Dell Inc. be awarded a  
11 declaration that it has not infringed and is not infringing U.S. Patent  
12 No. 6,349,295;
- 13 (5) On its Second Counterclaim, Defendant Hewlett-Packard Company  
14 be awarded a declaration that it has not infringed and is not infringing  
15 U.S. Patent No. 6,349,295;
- 16 (6) Defendants Microsoft Corporation's, Dell Inc.'s, and Hewlett-Packard  
17 Company's First Counterclaims for Invalidity are dismissed without  
18 prejudice to Defendants' asserting such counterclaims in the event  
19 this matter is remanded for any reason, including for further  
20 consideration; and
- 21 (7) Defendants Microsoft Corporation, Dell Inc., and Hewlett-Packard  
22 Company, as prevailing parties, recover costs from Plaintiff in the
