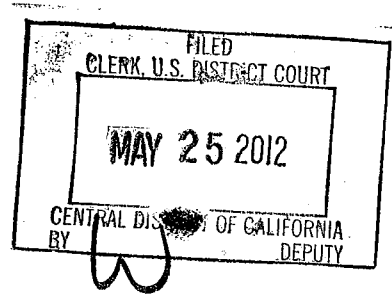

1 **TO ALL PARTIES AND THEIR COUNSEL OF RECORD:**

2 On May 21, 2012, the Court having granted the Motion of defendants
3 JPMorgan Chase Bank, N.A. ("JPMorgan"), an acquirer of certain assets and
4 liabilities of Washington Mutual Bank from the FDIC acting as Receiver, erroneously
5 sued as JPMorgan Chase, NA, successor in interest to Washington Mutual Bank, F.A.,
6 successor in interest to Long Beach Mortgage Company; Deutsche Bank National
7 Trust Company, as trustee for Long Beach Mortgage Loan Trust 2006-6 ("Deutsche"),
8 and California Reconveyance Company ("CRC" and collectively "Defendants"), for
9 an order dismissing the complaint of plaintiff Monica Sciarratta ("Plaintiff") without
10 leave to amend:

11 IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that:

- 12 1. The Complaint of Plaintiff is dismissed with prejudice in its entirety as to
13 Defendants, and each of them.
- 14 2. Judgment is entered in favor of Defendants, and each of them. Plaintiff
15 shall take nothing against Defendants in the above-captioned action.
- 16 3. Defendants shall recover from Plaintiff the costs of suit relating to the
17 Complaint. Defendants, as the prevailing parties, are allowed to file a Bill of Costs.
