On October 9, 2009, Plaintiff filed in the Ninth Circuit a petition for permission to 2 appeal from the Court's order denying Plaintiff's motion for remand, which this Court certified 3 for interlocutory appeal pursuant to 28 U.S.C. Section 1292(b). 4 3. On November 9, 2009 Defendant filed a motion for summary adjudication in the 5 York action. That motion is scheduled for hearing on November 30, 2009. 6 4. A ruling by the Ninth Circuit on Plaintiff's petition for appeal and/or a ruling on 7 Defendant's motion for summary judgment in the *York* action will likely render moot the motion 8 in this action presently scheduled for hearing on December 19, 2009. If the Ninth Circuit grants 9 Plaintiff's petition for appeal, the parties will mutually request a stay pending ultimate resolution 10 by the Ninth Circuit of the jurisdictional issue to be decided on appeal. If the Ninth Circuit 11 denies Plaintiff's petition for appeal and Defendant's motion for summary adjudication is denied, 12 the parties will stipulate to a transfer of this action to the Central District. If the Ninth Circuit 13 denies Plaintiff's petition for appeal and Defendant's motion for summary adjudication is granted, the York action may no longer include any of the claims asserted by Plaintiff in this 14 15 action.
