Plaintiff did not purchase the product and other than the name "Toys-R-Us," Plaintiff has been unable to ascertain far been unable to determine the location through third party sources, although it was purchased in Southern California. remainder of the potential defendants cannot reasonably be ascertained by Plaintiffs until sufficient discovery into this matter has been conducted.
- For these reasons, the parties stipulate to add TOYS 'R' US-6. DELAWARE, INC. as a defendant in place of DOE 1.
