## PROCEEDINGS (in Chambers):

The Court is in receipt of Defendant Northland Insurance Company's supplement to its opposition to Plaintiff LM Insurance Corporation's ("LMI") motion for summary judgment. The supplemental opposition raises a new argument - one that Northland failed to include in either its previous motion for summary judgment or in its opposition to LMI's motion. Even though Northland has had over two weeks to seek leave to file a supplemental brief, Northland waited to file its supplement until 4:00 p.m. on Friday, April 2, 2004, even though LMI's reply was due on Monday, April 5, 2004.

Northland's supplemental brief raises an important issue that potentially impacts all the parties to this litigation and both of the pending summary judgment motions. Therefore, rather than strike Northland's untimely filing, the Court orders that the hearing date for both summary judgment motions be CONTINUED. The new hearing date is Monday, April 19, 2004 at 9:30 a.m. Both LMI and Plaintiff in Intervention, the Insurance Company of the State of Pennsylvania, may file reply briefs on or before Monday, April 12, 2004.
