- (c) using any simulation, reproduction, counterfeit, copy, or colorable imitation of the registered trademark or service marks of Stephen J. Ford, including specifically Trademark Registration No. 2,496,500, and Service Mark Registration Nos. 2,108,510 and 2,115,806, in connection with the manufacture, distribution, offering for distribution, sale, offering for sale, advertisement, promotion, broadcast or display of any product or service;
- (d) using, creating, promotion, operating, or maintaining any web site bearing, in whole or in part, the name "thecarguyshow.com" or "carguyshow.com" or "carguy.com"
- (d) engaging in any other activity constituting an infringement of any of trademark or service mark registered to Stephen J. Ford;
- (e) assisting, aiding, or abetting any other person, business or entity in engaging in, or performing, any of the activities referred to in paragraphs (a) through (d) above; and
