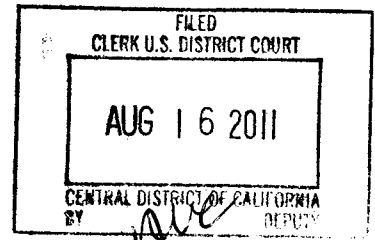

1 The Court, having taken the matter under submission, issued its *Order*
2 *Granting Defendants' Motion for Summary Judgment on Copyright Claims and*
3 *Dismissing State Law Claims for Lack of Subject Matter Jurisdiction* ("Order") on

6 IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the plaintiff Pamela Lawrence take
7 nothing, and that this action be dismissed on the merits as to plaintiff's First, Second

9 and Vicarious Infringement, respectively, and dismissed for lack of subject matter
10 jurisdiction as to plaintiff's Fourth and Fifth Causes of Action for breach of contract
11 and fraud, respectively.

12 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all defendants are the prevailing parties in
13 this action, and are entitled to recover their costs.
