1	show such cause in writing by filing a declaration signed under penalty of perjury. In
2	particular, plaintiff's declaration must address why the Motion has not been filed, even
3	though it was due 6 days ago. Failure to timely file such a declaration or to show cause as
4	ordered will result in dismissal of this action for failure to prosecute and/or to comply with
5	a court order.
6	Filing of the Motion shall be a satisfactory response to the Order to Show Cause.
7	However, absent exceptional circumstances, no extensions will be granted for the filing of
8	the Motion.
