24 Being fully qualified a physically disabled person, due to the  
25 a Hack's to plaintiff that disabled both the Right Arm and Leg  
26 entirely, and needing extensive surgeries Unavailable to plaintiff  
27 at this time. Plaintiff would thus request that the US Mar-


2 Service Fees:

3 An plaintiff permitted to proceed IFP, may not be required to pay  
4 Service Fees to the Marshall for serving summons, civil complaint and the  
5 motion for injunctive relief-~~ex parte~~ as costs, there being no statutory  
6 authority for permitting recovery of such items by clerk and Marshall eit-  
7 her under 28USCS § 1915; or 28USCS § 1920; And Controlling statutes  
8 require the court to appoint the US Marshall or other person or officer to  
9 effectuate service for an IFP plaintiff, as in Lindsey v. U.S. BAB (1996)  
10 101 F3d 444, 36 FR Serv 3d 827.

11 Request for appointment of counsel, per 28USCS § 1915(d) and FACivP 23(a) as  
12 an Class Action for the ADA Act of 1990 on the disadvantaged, out disenfranchised,  
13 indigent and homeless Class. And per FACivP 23(a)(1), (2), (3) and (4) are all  
14 relevant to the above captioned complaint, with the class numbering over  
15 10,000 easily, the questions of law or fact are common to the entire class,  
16 as are the partial listing of claims typical of the class, and this pla-  
17 intiff will fairly and adequately present and protect the interests of the  
18 class, and per 28USCS § 1711. Also invoking 28USCS § 1715(a)(2); notification  
19 of the states Attorney General, E.G. Brown, in that plaintiff will be requ-  
20 esting further motions for injunctive relief i.e. prohibitory and restraini-  
21 g injunctions to the state also.

22 And plaintiff is submitting medical documents concerning the 2  
23 inguinal hernias awaiting surgery, and the podiatry surgery for the  
24 right foot's 2 deformed toes - neither of which plaintiff may receive.
