 18 Plaintiff Guardian Pool Fence Systems, Inc. ("Guardian") having
 19 commenced this action for an injunction and other relief against Defendant
 20 Donald Muir ("Muir") for infringement of a registered trademark, breach of
 21 contract and unfair competition, and

22 Muir having entered into a Settlement Agreement with Guardian and
 23 having stipulated to entry of this Permanent Injunction and Judgment,

24 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Defendant Muir is permanently enjoined
 25 from using GUARDIAN, alone or in combination with other words, symbols, or
 26 designs, as a trade name, trademark, service mark, Internet domain name, email
 27 address, and Internet metatag, keyword or search term, in connection with pool
 28 fences as well as products and services which are complementary thereto.
