16	By order dated September 10, 2010, plaintiffs were ordered to serve the summons and	
17	complaint ("Complaint") on all named defendants in this action within sixty (60) days of the filing

22	shall show cause, if any there be, why this action should not be dismissed as against defendant	
23	Laurie J. Reese for plaintiffs' failure to complete service of the summons and complaint as	
24	required by Rule 4(m), Federal Rules of Civil Procedure. Plaintiffs shall attempt to show such	
25	cause in writing by filing a declaration signed under penalty of perjury. <sup>1</sup> Failure to timely

1	file such a declaration or to show cause as ordered may result in dismissal of this action
2	against defendant Laurie J. Reese for failure to prosecute. Filing of the proof of service
3	shall be a satisfactory response to the Order to Show Cause.
