Proceedings: ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

Failure of counsel to timely and adequately respond as required herein SHALL be deemed plaintiff's abandonment of the above action. In that event, the above matter will be dismissed without further notice from the Court, without prejudice for failure to diligently prosecute and for failure to comply with the Court's order.
