20	I, Dr. Miguel Dominguez, declare as follows:	
21	1. I am a Professor in the Modern Languages Department at California State	
22	University, Dominguez Hills.	
23	2. I served as Chair of the Student Grade Appeals Board after Dr. Whetstone	
24	stepped down from that role during the 2010/2011 academic year.	
25	3. In January of 2011, Dr. Gus Martin brought to my attention that Tarikh	
26	Demepke raised a procedural concern over the handling of his grade appeal in HUS 460.	
27	Dr. Martin explained that Mr. Demekpe was threatening to file a lawsuit, so he had	
28	offered to have the newly constituted Student Grade Appeals Board re-review the prior	

Board's decision.

- 4. A quorum of the members of the Appeals Board met on January 24, 2011, and agreed to re-read the file and review the prior Board's decision. I confirmed this agreement in an email dated January 27, 2011.
- 5. Dr. Sheela Pawar responded on January 28, 2011, stating that she concurred with the previous decision of the Board. A true and correct copy of her responsive email is submitted as CSU Exhibit No. 49.
- 6. Dr. Kirti Celly, who also sat on the prior Board, indicated concurrence in the prior Board's decision.
- 7. On February 2, 2011, Dr. Gus Martin sent me an email stating that Mr. Demekpe had again threatened to file a lawsuit. I forwarded that email to Wei Ma and the two students on the Board (Ms. Gray and Ms. Bradshaw) reminding them I needed their input. Professor Ma responded on February 3, 2011, finding that the case should be dropped. A true and correct copy of that email exchange is submitted as CSU Exhibit No. 50.
- 8. With a quorum consisting of the Board faculty members and by majority vote, the Board determined to affirm the prior decision of the Appeals Board and to deny the grade appeal, finding "no cause" existed for such an appeal.
- 9. On February 15, 2011, I prepared the decision and circulated it to Mr. Demekpe and Professor Escamilla, with a copy to Dean Joshi, Ginger Wilson, and Dr. Martin. A true and correct copy is submitted as CSU Exhibit No. 51.
