23 ORDERED that Plaintiff's Motion to Expedite Discovery is GRANTED; it is further

24 ORDERED that Plaintiff is allowed to serve immediate discovery on the internet service
 25 providers (ISPs) to obtain the identity of each DOE Defendant by serving a Rule 45 subpoena
 26 that seeks information sufficient to identify each Defendant, including name, current (and
 27 permanent) addresses, telephone numbers, email addresses, and Media Access Control
 addresses; it is further

28 ORDERED that Plaintiff is allowed to serve a Rule 45 subpoena in the same manner as

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1 above to any ISP that is identified in response to a subpoena as a provider of internet services
2 to one of the DOE Defendants; it is further

3 ORDERED any information disclosed to Plaintiff in response to a Rule 45 subpoena may
4 be used by Plaintiff solely for the purpose of protecting Plaintiff's rights as set forth in its
5 Complaint; it is further

6 ORDERED that if and when an ISP is served with a subpoena, the ISP shall give written
7 notice, which may include email notice, to the subscribers in question within five business days;
8 it is further

9 ORDERED that if the ISP and/or any Defendant wants to move to quash the subpoena,
10 the party must do so before the return date of the subpoena, which shall be 25 days from the
11 date of service; it is further

12 ORDERED that the ISP shall preserve any subpoenaed information pending the
13 resolution of any timely filed motion to quash; and it is further

14 ORDERED that Plaintiff shall provide each ISP with a copy of this Order and
15 accompanying Memorandum Opinion along with its subpoena.
