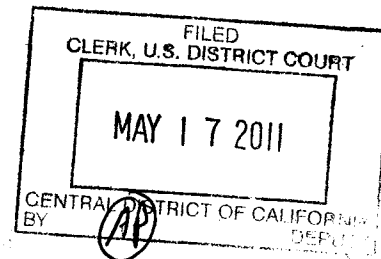

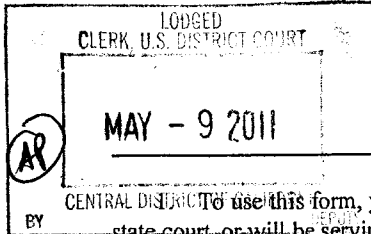

- 2. In this petition, you may challenge the judgment entered by only one California state court. If you want to challenge the judgment entered by a different California state court, you must file a separate petition.
3. Make sure the form is typed or neatly handwritten. You must tell the truth and sign the form. If you make a false statement of a material fact, you may be prosecuted for perjury.
4. Answer all the questions. You do not need to cite case law, but you do need to state the federal legal theory and operative facts in support of each ground. You may submit additional pages if necessary. If you do not fill out the form properly, you will be asked to submit additional or correct information. If you want to submit a legal brief or arguments, you may attach a separate memorandum.
5. You must include in this petition all the grounds for relief from the conviction and/or sentence that you challenge. And you must state the facts that support each ground. If you fail to set forth all the grounds in this petition, you may be barred from presenting additional grounds at a later date.
5. You must pay a fee of \$5.00. If the fee is paid, your petition will be filed. If you cannot afford the fee, you may ask to proceed in forma pauperis (as a poor person). To do that, you must fill out and sign the declaration of the last two pages of the form. Also, you must have an authorized officer at the penal institution complete the certificate as to the amount of money and securities on deposit to your credit in any account at the institution. If your prison account exceeds \$25.00, you must pay the filing fee.

GROUND 1

PETITIONER'S TRIAL COURT ERRONEOUSLY ADMITTED EVIDENCE OF PRIOR "BAD ACTS" IN VIOLATION OF HIS CONSTITUTIONAL RIGHT TO DUE PROCESS.

STATEMENT OF FACTS THAT SUPPORT THE GROUND:

DURING THE HEARING ON THE 1101(b) ISSUE, TRIAL COUNSEL ARGUED THAT THE PRIOR OFFENSE WAS TOO DISSIMILAR TO SHOW PETITIONER'S INTENT AND/OR MOTIVE FOR SHOOTING IN THE INSTANT CASE, A DRIVE-BY SHOOTING. COUNSEL FURTHER ARGUED THAT UNDER EVIDENCE CODE SECTION 352, THE PREJUDICIAL EFFECT OF THIS EVIDENCE OUTWEIGHTS ITS PROBATIVE VALUE, AND THUS, SHOULD BE EXCLUDED AT TRIAL (1CT 214-225; 2RT 29-31)

COURT OVERRULED TRIAL COUNSEL'S OBJECTION AND RULED THAT THE PROSECUTION COULD USE THE FACTS OF THE PRIOR UNCHARGED INCIDENT TO PROVE INTENT AND MOTIVE FOR THE SHOOTING IN THE PRESENT CASE. (2RT 31-33.) THE COURT'S RULING ALLOWING "BAD ACTS" EVIDENCE IN AT TRIAL WAS ONLY IMPERMISSIBLE PURSUANT TO EVIDENCE CODE SECTION 1101, BUT IT ALSO IMPERMISSIBLY VIOLATION PETITIONER'S FEDERAL DUE PROCESS RIGHTS AND DEPRIVED HIM A FAIR TRIAL.

GROUND 2

PETITIONER'S 14 AMENDMENT DUE PROCESS RIGHTS WERE VIOLATED BY JURY'S TRUE FINDINGS ON COUNT ONE MURDER FIRST DEGREE WITH SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCE ON DRIVE-BY SHOOTING AND GANG ALLEGATIONS, BASED ON INSUFFICIENT EVIDENCE TO SUPPORT THE FINDING, RENDERING THE DETERMINATION REVERSIBLE PER SE. JACKSON V. VIRGINIA (1979) 443 U.S. 307.

STATEMENT OF FACTS THAT SUPPORT THE GROUND:

THE INFORMATION CHARGED THAT THE SUBSTANTIVE COUNT ONE FIRST DEGREE MURDER WERE COMMITTED WITH SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCE ON DRIVE-BY SHOOTING AND GANG ALLEGATIONS. HOWEVER, THE EVIDENCE FELL SHORT IN THIS CASE, PETITIONER WAS CONVICTED AFTER PROSECUTION SOLE WITNESS AT THE CRIME SCENE, MICHAEL FREEMAN WHO TESTIFIED HE NEVER SEEN WHO WAS THE ACTUAL SHOOTER, HOW THE WEAPON WAS DISCHARGED, FURTHERMORE, NEVER HEARD NO ONE SAYING ANY GANG NAMES OR SYMBOLS. NOT WITHSTANDING THE EVIDENCE INTRODUCED AT TRIAL FALL FAR SHORT OF THE SUFFICIENCY OF EVIDENCE NECESSARY TO ESTABLISH THE REQUISITE STANDARD OF FIRST DEGREE MURDER, SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCE OF DRIVE-BY SHOOTING AND GANG ALLEGATIONS.

COUNSEL FAILED TO PRESENT ANY WITNESSES OR REQUEST FOR ANY EXPERTS ON BEHALF OF THE PETITIONER, TO PRESENT POTENTIAL WITNESSES OR REQUEST FOR EXPERTS VIOLATED PETITIONER'S RIGHT TO A FAIR TRIAL UNDER THE SIXTH AMENDMENT RIGHT TO EFFECTIVE ASSISTANCE OF COUNSEL.

THE PROSECUTION'S MISSTATEMENT OF MATERIAL FACTS WERE USED TO OBTAIN PETITIONER'S CONVICTION.

STATEMENT OF FACTS THAT SUPPORT GROUND:

PROSECUTION MADE IMPROPER STATEMENTS TO SOME LETTERS THAT WERE PRESENTED TO THE JURY. THOSE LETTERS WERE NEVER BROUGHT ON RECORD. THEY WERE INTRODUCED BY PROSECUTION TO SHOW A CONSCIOUSNESS OF GUILT (SCT 3365) STATEMENTS BY PROSECUTION IN HIS ARGUMENT TO ALLUDING TO FACTS NOT EVIDENCE, CONSTITUTE MISCONDUCT, PROSECUTION MADE STATEMENTS ON HIS OWN BELIEFS AND ASSUMPTIONS ON TRYING TO INTERPRET THESE LETTERS, FURTHERMORE, REFERRING TO SUPPOSED FACTS OF THESE ALLEGED LETTERS THERE IS NO PROOF AND DOCUMENTATION OF THESE LETTERS.
