

Pursuant to the "Memorandum Opinion and Order (1) Granting Motion 1 of Defendants California Public Utilities Commission and Commissioners to 2 Dismiss Seventh Amended Complaint [ECF No. 316]; and (2) Denying 3 Plaintiffs' Renewed Motion for Leave to File Eighth Amended and Third 4 Supplemental Complaint [ECF No. 322]" entered substantially 5 contemporaneously herewith, and in accordance with Rule 58 of the Federal 6 Rules of Civil Procedure, 7 It is hereby ORDERED, ADJUDGED, and DECREED as follows: 8 This Court possesses subject matter jurisdiction over the above-9 1. captioned action pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1331 and 16 U.S.C. §§ 824a-3, et seq. 10 Plaintiffs Solutions for Utilities, Inc. and Californians for 2. 11 Renewable Energy, Inc. were previously **DISMISSED**. Defendant Southern 12 13 California Edison Co. was previously DISMISSED. The operative pleading is the Seventh Amended Complaint [ECF 14 3. No. 298] filed by Plaintiffs Michael E. Boyd and Robert Sarvey (jointly, 15 "Plaintiffs"). 16 The Seventh Amended Complaint is **DISMISSED without leave** 17 4. to amend. Defendants California Public Utilities Commission and the current 18 Commissioners of the CPUC shall have JUDGMENT in their favor, and 19 **AGAINST** Plaintiffs. Plaintiffs shall take nothing by way of their Seventh 20 Amended Complaint.
