MOTION TO VACATE, SET ASIDE OR CORRECT CONVICTION AND SENTENCE BY A PERSON IN FEDERAL CUSTODY PURSUANT TO 28 U.S.C. §2255; MOTION TO WAIVE APPEARANCE

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1. Judgment was entered by the United States District Court for the Central District of California, the Honorable Judge Dean Pregerson presiding, in case number CR-06-00044-DDP. Judgment was entered on August 27, 2010.

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2. Movant was sentenced to a term of 78 months incarceration.

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3. Movant was convicted in Count 1 of Conspiracy (18 U.S.C.

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§371), Counts 2-10 of Bank Fraud (18 U.S.C. §1344(1)), Count 11 of

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False Statement on Tax Return (26 U.S.C. §7206(1)), and Count 12 of

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4. Movant pleaded guilty to the referenced counts.

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6. No appeal has been filed at this time. Movant gave up his right to appeal his sentence, however, he did not waive an ineffective assistance of counsel claim, or certain other claims, all pursuant to paragraph 60 of his plea agreement.

7. No other appeals, motions, petitioner, or applications have been filed concerning the judgment of conviction in any court,

8. The ground upon which this motion is based is that Movant was denied his Sixth Amendment right to the effective assistance of counsel during the sentencing phase of his case.

Movant is <u>not</u> attacking the length of his sentence. Rather, Movant believes that but for counsel's conduct below, the Court would have ordered 2 to 3 years of Movant's sentence to be served in home confinement. Movant states the following reasons:

a. Counsel repeatedly stated to Movant that Movant would be sentenced to 3 to 4 years of incarceration, thereby causing Movant to not consider asking the Court for a portion of his sentence to be served in home confinement.

b. Counsel never provided Movant with a draft or final copy of Movant's sentencing memorandum, and did not seek input from Movant regarding same.

c. Counsel never provided Movant with a draft or final copy of the investigator's report and reference letters, and did not seek input from Movant regarding same.

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- d . Counsel never provided Movant with a copy of the Government's sentencing memorandum, and only told Movant about the sentence the Government was seeking a few minutes before the sentencing hearing.
- Counsel may have never filed an objection to the inaccuracies in Movant's pre-sentence report, or if he did file an objection, he never provided Movant with a copy.
- f. Counsel did not ask the Court for home confinement at the sentencing hearing, despite his statement to Movant that he would make such a request. Counsel also told Movant after the hearing that counsel would file a request for home confinement nine months after petitioner had begun his incarceration, however, he has not done so, and he had no legal authority to make such a statement.
- Counsel failed to argue to the Court that Movant would continue to engage in substantial post-sentencing cooperation with Movant's victim banks and the Receiver in their civil cases.
- The sole ground for issuance of relief cannot be properly raised in a direct appeal from his conviction and sentence because he waived that appeal right in his plea agreement.
- No prior petition of motion has been filed by Movant addressing the issue raised in this motion. Movant has no other means to achieve a speedy resolution of the issue raised in this 24 motion.
- Movant has no other petition, motion, or appeal pending 26 in any Court challenging the conviction in this case.

- 12. Movant was represented at the sentencing by Michael R. Belter, whose address is 16 Marengo, Suite 619, Pasadena, CA 91101.
- 13. Movant was sentenced on the 12 counts referenced in the plea agreement.
- 14. Movant has no other sentence in state or federal court to serve.

Movant requests the Court to waive his appearance at any hearing based on this motion.

WHEREFORE, Movant asks this Court to grant this motion, and amend Movant's sentence to provide for the last 2 to 3 years to be served in home confinement.

I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct and that this motion under 28 U.S.C. $\S 2255$ was placed in the prison mailing system (mailbox rule) on August 2011.
