ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE REGARDING PLAINTIFF'S FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH SCHEDULING ORDER AND TO FILE STATUS REPORT

On June 18, 2014, this Court issued a Case Management and Scheduling Order ("Case Management Order") which directed each party, <u>inter alia</u>, to file and serve a status report no later than August 18, 2014. <u>See</u> Case Management Order, ¶ 10. Although defendants timely filed such a status report, plaintiff did not do so. To date, plaintiff has failed to file a status report or to seek an extension of time to do so.

Plaintiff is cautioned that the failure to comply with this order and/or to show good cause, may result in the imposition of sanctions, including the dismissal of this action for failure to prosecute.
