4 defendant Pullen Associates, Inc., and for good cause shown,

5 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED** that:

6 Plaintiffs Trustees of the Southern California Pipe Trades Health and Welfare
7 Trust Fund, Trustees of the Southern California Pipe Trades Pensioners and Surviving
8 Spouses Health Fund, Trustees of the Southern California Pipe Trades Retirement
9 Trust Fund, Trustees of the Southern California Pipe Trades Defined Contribution
10 Trust Fund, Trustees of the Southern California Pipe Trades Vacation and Holiday
11 Trust Fund, Trustees of the Southern California Pipe Trades Christmas Bonus Fund,
12 Trustees of the Apprentice and Journeyman Training Trust Fund, Trustees of the
13 Plumbers and Pipefitters National Pension Fund, and Trustees of the International
14 Training shall recover from defendant, Pullen Associates, Inc. doing business as
15 "Vision Mechanical Services," the principal amount of \$67,866.79, plus pre-judgment
16 and post-judgment interest thereon at the rate of eight percent (8%) accruing from
17 March 15, 2012, until paid in full.
