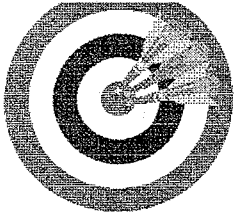

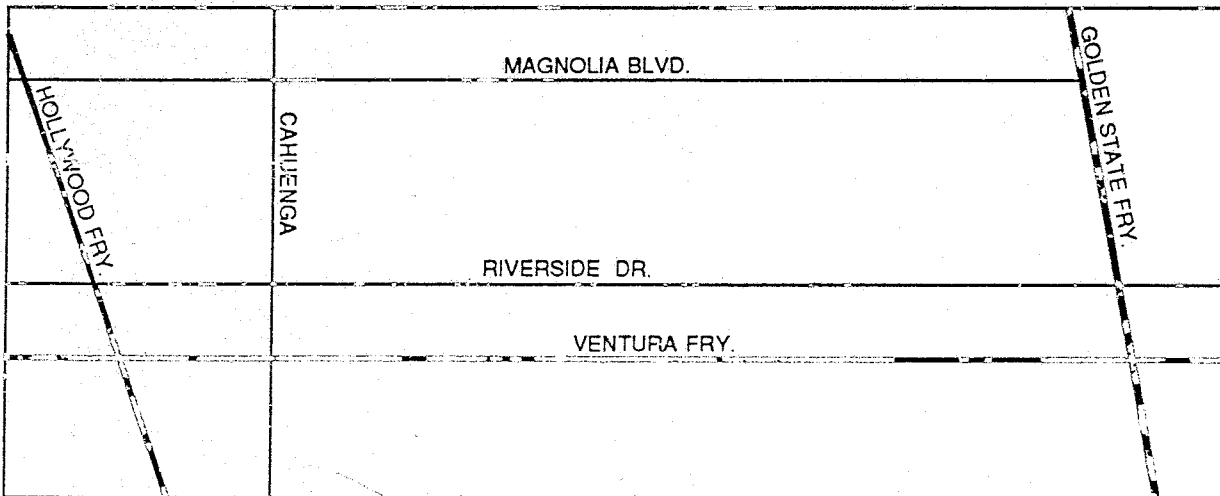

- 1 Set of Mixed Doubles (consisting of the Open Singles Champ and the Ladies Singles Champ of each Association) (301 best 2 of 3, double on and off) for 1 point. NCDCA will shoot for the Bull 1st in game 1. Second leg is 'Mugs Away'. Third leg, if necessary, will have SCDCA shooting for the Bull first.

5 more sets of Singles as above. However 1st shot at the Bull will be the reverse of above.

1 Singles match between the Ladies Champion of each Association (301 best 2 of 3, double on and off) for 1 point.

5 Sets of Doubles (301 best 2 of 3, double on and off) worth 2 points each. NCDCA will shoot for the Bull 1st in all games (1st leg). Second leg is 'Mugs Away'. Third leg, if necessary, will have SCDCA shooting for the Bull first.

1 Team Match (1001, best 2 of 3) for a total of 3 points. Legs 1 and 3 will be a straight shoot (no double on required). Leg 2 will be double on. NCDCA will shoot for the Bull first in the 1st leg. Leg 2 will be 'Mugs Away'. Leg 3, if necessary, will have SCDCA shooting for the Bull first. NOTE: The Team Match shall consist of a minimum of 10 players from each team. If BOTH CAPTAINS agree, a maximum of two players may be added to each team as long as both teams have an equal number of players.

The match will be played to the full 25 point conclusion. Players are asked to limit themselves to a 9-dart warm-up on the game board.

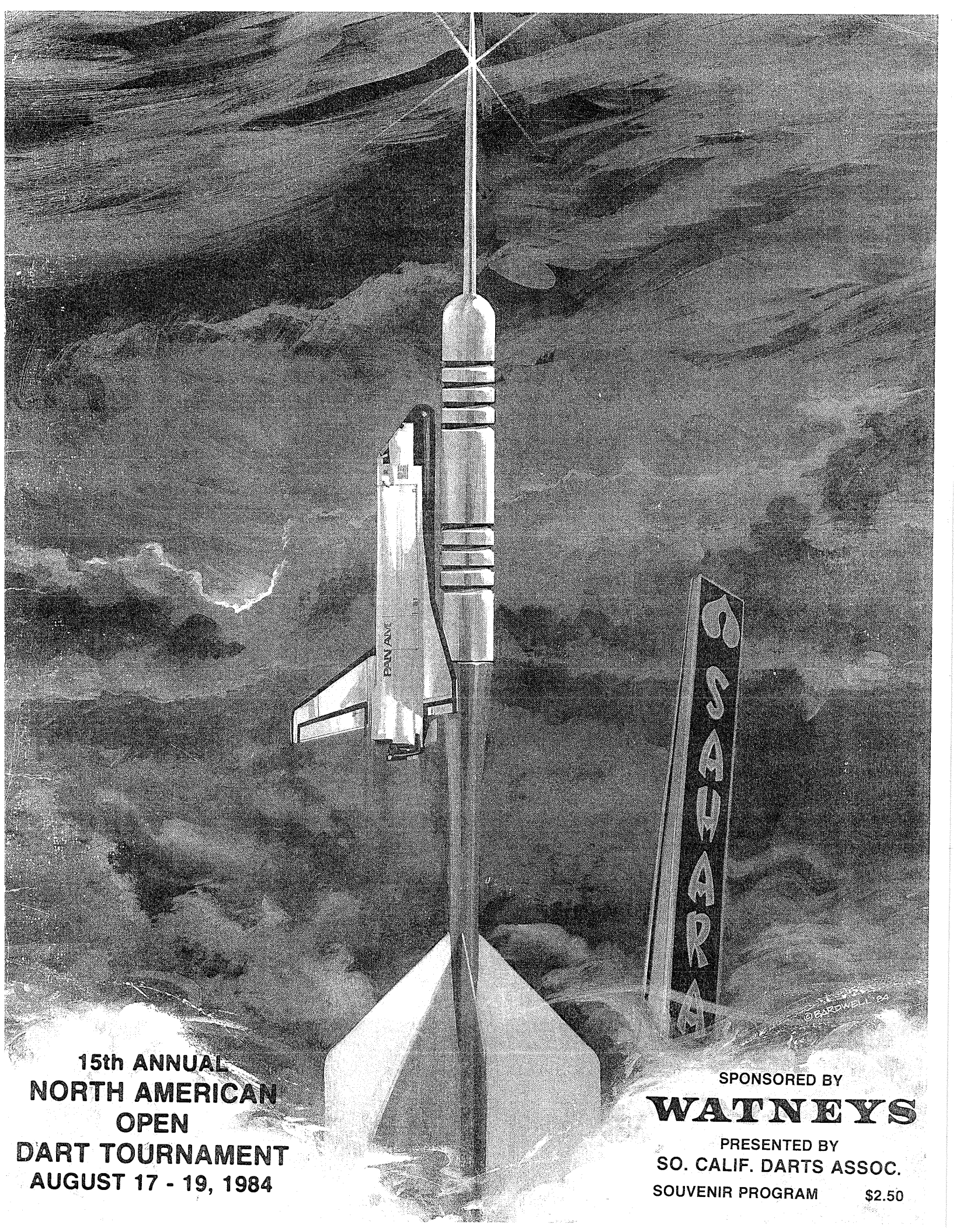

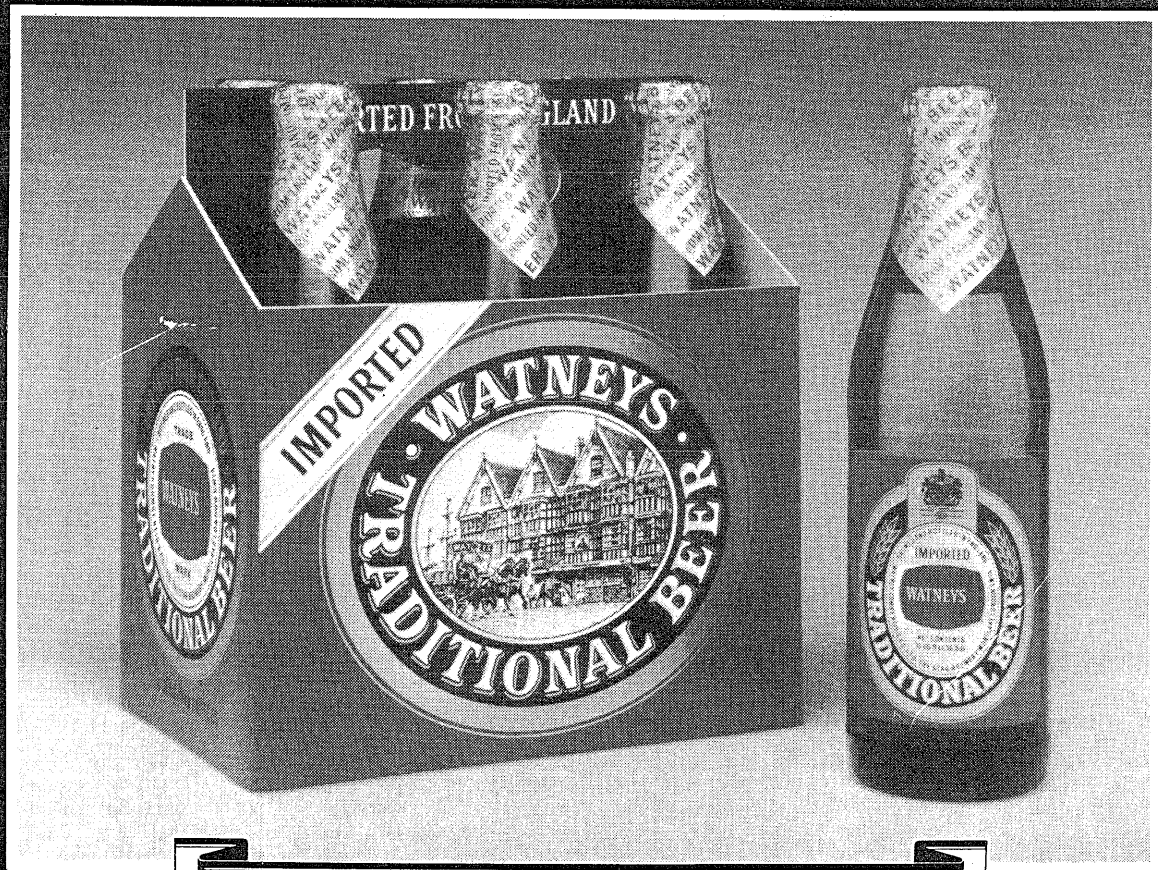
