L. DAVID IRETE UNDER FIRE FOR ANOTHER FOOLISH COMMENT “Defendants Distancing Themselves From Irete”

GLENDALE, CALIF. February 12, 2012 — Defendants in the lawsuit entitled Southern California Darts Association, Inc. v. L. David Irete, et al. are in an uproar over the abhorrent leadership of **L. David Irete** and others who caused them to be sued.

By Irete and others’ own admission they failed to act appropriately which ultimately caused at least 73 members of their unincorporated association and 8 businesses to be defendants in this lawsuit.

It was reported by Chris Vogel of *LA Weekly*, “*That night at the Robin Hood, Irete, Harvey Fischer, Milan Sabata and Curtis Pierpoint, a residential construction worker, all talked briefly about Zaffina’s latest news. They, along with other players, decided there was nothing they could do about it right away, so they carried on with the planned administrative matters and league elections. Irete was named president; Pierpoint won the vice president slot.*” [LA Weekly Article—February 3-9, 2012, Vol. 34, No. II, laweekly.com].

Ironically, this characterization is as false as many of the lies told by Vogel in the article and ratified by the publication’s editor, Sarah Fenske. They were provided the truth, yet they refused to honor it.

Witnesses at the aforementioned meeting, reported that Irete stated, “***F*#k Dino, we are going to move forward has if he doesn’t exist.***” [Several Witnesses’ Account]. Irete’s comment was allegedly recorded by one of the members present; however, to date, this member has not provided SCDA with the cell phone recording and his/her identity has not yet been ascertained.

In just the last few days, since our press release dated February 9, 2012, which provided evidence of the absurdness known as the “*William F. Lynch SLAPP Suit,*” SCDA has been contacted by many defendants expressing their desire to be released from the lawsuit.

As, has always been the case since August 29, 2011, and later, after September 26, 2011, SCDA, through its President and CEO, Dino M. Zaffina, has been **open and civil** with “*every*” defendant and lawyer representing their client(s). To date, many defendants have already been released from the lawsuit. **The defendants have always had this opportunity!**

OLD ADAGE: BE CAREFUL WHAT YOU WISH FOR

GLENDALE, CALIF. March 1, 2012 — The issue of transferring the lawsuit entitled Southern California Darts Association, Inc. v. L. David Irete, et al. had been ruled on by the Court on January 20, 2012, wherein Plaintiff, Southern California Darts Association, Inc. (“SCDA”) opposed the transfer and Defendant, William F. Lynch, represented by Danny Abrahamian argued in favor of the transfer. The Court ruled “*Court finds case does not qualify as complex.*”

At the Case Management Conference on January 26, 2012, the Court appeared to have second thoughts. The Court continued the matter to February 9, 2012. Upon returning to court, the parties were instructed to complete questionnaires. The Court informed the parties that the Complex Litigation Department wanted to review the completed questionnaires before making a decision. Thereafter, an Order would be issued designating the destination of the case.

SCDA received the Court’s Order on March 1, 2012. The Honorable Judge Emilie H. Elias determined that the case should be designated as complex. The case was assigned to the Honorable Judge Elihu M. Berle in Department 323 at Central Civil West Courthouse located at 600 South Commonwealth Avenue, Los Angeles, California 90005 for all further proceedings.

Transferring the case to Complex Litigation has no special affect on SCDA. On the other hand, the transfer has big consequences on all the defendants. It appears that the attorneys who argued for the transfer (e.g., Danny Abrahamian, Mike Zuk, and James Kawahito) inferably did not advise their clients of the “*additional fees*” that will be required. Each and every defendant who has already responded is required to pay, within 10-days, a **\$550.00 fee** in addition to the **\$395.00** first response fee. And, the defendants that have not already paid the first response fee will be required to pay **\$945.00**.

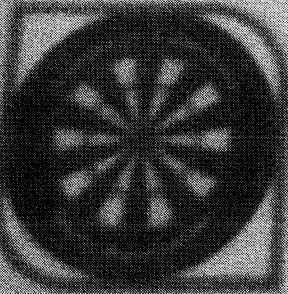
