 18 O R D E R

19 JAROSLAV MELKA ("the fugitive"), having appeared before the  
 20 undersigned judicial officer, represented by counsel, on May 7,  
 21 2012, and having entered into the foregoing stipulation,

22 IT IS HEREBY FOUND as follows:

23 1. The fugitive's stipulation to all elements of  
 24 extradition is intelligent and voluntary and are made after he  
 25 was fully advised of his rights in this country pursuant to the  
 26 extradition treaty in force between the United States and the  
 27 Czech Republic and applicable federal statutes.

1           2.     The fugitive has been convicted in the Czech Republic  
2 of the three counts of embezzlement on January 28, 2003, and of  
3 two counts of fraud on July 29, 2004. On May 6, 2005, the  
4 District Court in Prostějov, in the Czech Republic, issued an  
5 international arrest warrant for the fugitive's arrest.

6           3.     All the elements of extradition are met as to each  
7 offense, specifically:

8           a.     The assigned judicial officer, United States  
9 Magistrate Judge Charles F. Eick, and the court on which that  
10 judicial officer sits, have jurisdiction to conduct extradition  
11 proceedings.

12           b.     The assigned judicial officer, United States  
13 Magistrate Judge Charles F. Eick, and the court on which that  
14 judicial officer sits, have jurisdiction over the fugitive.

15           c.     An extradition treaty is in force between the  
16 United States of America and the Czech Republic ("the Extradition  
17 Treaty").

18           d.     The fugitive is sought for offenses for which the  
19 applicable treaty permits extradition.

20           e.     The fugitive is the individual who is charged in  
21 the Czech Republic arrest warrant and there is probable cause to  
22 believe him guilty of each of the charged offenses.

23           4.     There are no facts that bar the extradition of the  
24 fugitive under the Extradition Treaty.

25           FURTHERMORE, based on the foregoing findings, the  
26 undersigned judicial officer HEREBY CERTIFIES THE FUGITIVE'S  
27 EXTRADITABILITY and ORDERS that the Clerk of the Court forward  
28 this Order to the United States Secretary of State for the

1 issuance of a surrender warrant or such other actions as the  
2 Secretary of State may deem appropriate. The Clerk of Court  
3 shall send a certified copy of this Order to:


