PROCEEDINGS (IN CHAMBERS): ORDER DISMISSING ACTION WITH PREJUDICE

On July 3, 2012, the Court granted Defendants' Motion to Dismiss. (Docket No. 22). Given the evident futility of amendment, the Court ordered Plaintiff Terence Michael Agee to show cause why this action should not be dismissed with prejudice, including what changes he would make if granted leave to file a First Amended Complaint. Agee filed an Answer to Request on July 13, 2012. (Docket No. 23).
