After full consideration of the pleadings and papers on file in this case, the evidence on record, and the argument of counsel, and GOOD CAUSE APPEARING THEREFOR:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Plaintiffs, the Trustees of the Southern California IBEW-NECA Pension Plan, Trustees of the Southern California IBEW-NECA Health Trust Fund, Trustees of the Los Angeles County Electrical Educational and Training Trust Fund, Trustees of the National Electrical Benefit Fund, Trustees of the Southern California IBEW-NECA Labor-Management Cooperation Committee, Trustees of the National IBEW-NECA Labor-Management Cooperation Committee, Contract Compliance Fund, and Los Angeles Electrical Workers Credit Union, shall recover from Defendant Haik Babakhani, an individual doing business as "Pioneer Electric," the total amount of \$38,496.17 (consisting of \$18,875.61 in unpaid contributions, \$767.02 in interest on the unpaid contributions, \$3,775.12 in liquidated damages, \$14,580.50 in attorneys' fees, and \$497.92 in costs), plus post-judgment interest as provided by law from the date of entry of judgment herein.
