3 entered against plaintiff herein and any other judgments entered heretofore or hereafter in  
4 this action with respect to any other defendant are several as to each such defendant  
5 unless expressly stated in the judgment to be joint and several as to the particular  
6 defendants;

7 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that there is no just reason for delay in entry of this  
8 final judgment against plaintiff and in favor of United Technologies Corporation and,  
9 finding that good cause exists for entry of a separate judgment under Rule 54 of the  
10 Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, the Court expressly directs that the Clerk of the Court  
11 enter this separate judgment in favor of United Technologies Corporation and against  
12 plaintiff herein pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 54 notwithstanding whether  
13 this action remains pending against other defendants.
