6 3. Any proceeding before this Court to enforce the terms of this Consent
7 Judgment shall be resolved by motions without the necessity of filing a new action.

8 4. The permanent injunction will remain in full force and effect in
9 accordance with the Confidential Settlement Agreement unless and until modified
10 by this Court.

11 5. All other claims for relief asserted in the Action, including all claims
12 for monetary relief, are denied and dismissed with prejudice. Each Party shall bear
13 its own costs and attorneys' fees incurred in connection with this Action, including
14 but not limited to costs and fees incurred in connection with the Counterclaim filed
15 by Defendant in this Action.




