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1 THE COURT, having reviewed the Stipulation for Entry of  
2 Consent Judgment between the United States of America on behalf  
3 of its agency, the Department of Education, and Jesus G. Flores,  
4 defendant herein ("Defendant"), and it appearing that the United  
5 States of America is entitled to entry of a judgment against  
6 Defendant, and good cause existing.

7 IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that the United States  
8 of America shall have judgment against Defendant Jesus G. Flores  
9 as follows:

10 1. As a result of defaulted student loans, Defendant  
11 shall pay to the United States the principal sum of \$268,107.03,  
12 together with interest accrued to March 6, 2013, of \$93,184.76,  
13 for a total amount of \$361,291.79, and interest accruing at the  
14 legal rate from and after the date of judgment until satisfied.

15 2. The United States will record judgment liens with all  
16 County Recorders wherein Defendant resides or owns real  
17 property; however, as long as Defendant makes payments as set  
18 forth herein, the United States will otherwise take no action to  
19 enforce this Judgment.

20 3. Defendant shall pay the Judgment in monthly  
21 installments of One Hundred and Twenty-Five Dollars (\$125.00) on  
22 the first day of each month commencing on or before December 1,  
23 2013, until the Judgment is paid in full.

24 4. Defendant shall keep the attorneys for the United  
25 States informed in writing of any material change in his  
26 financial situation or ability to pay, and of any change in his  
27 employment, place of residence, or telephone number.

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1           5.     The monthly \$125.00 payment rate will be reevaluated  
2 in twelve (12) months and may be modified, as necessary, to take  
3 into account the changed economic circumstances of Defendant.  
4 For purpose of evaluation and possible modification, Defendant  
5 shall provide United States with a Financial Statement (Form OBD  
6 500), and a copy of his Federal Income Tax returns including all  
7 attachments, two (2) months prior to the first anniversary of  
8 the Judgment, and at the same time each year thereafter, until  
9 the Judgment is satisfied.


10           6.     Should Defendant become delinquent, after notice to  
11 cure and a reasonable opportunity to cure, in making any payment  
12 due hereunder, United States shall have the right to enforce the  
13 Consent Judgment for the remaining balance then due, after  
14 giving credit for any payments made.

15           7.     If the Defendant pays to the United States the sum of  
16 \$361,291.79, plus accrued interest on this sum as provided by  
17 law, the United States of America will deem the Judgment  
18 satisfied, and will provide to Defendant a Release of Lien(s)  
19 Under Abstract of Judgment for recording with the applicable  
20 County Recorder(s).

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1           8.     Each party to this Action shall bear its own costs.  
2           IT IS SO ORDERED.
