Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636, the Court has reviewed the Complaint, the parties' cross-motions for summary judgment, the Administrative Record, and all other records on file as well as the Report and Recommendation of U.S. Magistrate Judge. On October 17, 2014, Plaintiff filed objections to the R&R. On October 31, 2014, Defendant filed a response to Plaintiff's objections.
