

1 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Motion to Dismiss is GRANTED, and
2 that Plaintiffs' action against the Federal Defendants is DISMISSED;

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Plaintiffs Minister Victor McGee and
4 Billy Joe Johnson may not re-file the present claims against the Federal Defendants
5 without first applying for and receiving written authorization from this Federal
6 Court.

7 The claims against the remaining Defendants are REMANDED to the Los
8 Angeles County Superior Court for the State of California (SC120144) because
9 this Court determined that the RICO claims do not establish federal question
10 jurisdiction and are no longer claims in the case after the Federal Defendants are
11 dismissed.
