Lewis has not opposed the motion. Accordingly, the court 20 GRANTS Defendants' Motion to Dismiss. 21 Central District of California Local Rule 7-9 requires an 22 opposing party to file an opposition to any motion at least twentyone (21) days prior to the date designated for hearing the motion. 23 24 C.D. CAL. L.R. 7-9. Additionally, Local Rule 7-12 provides that 25 "[t]he failure to file any required document, or the failure to file it within the deadline, may be deemed consent to the granting 27 or denial of the motion." C.D. Cal. L.R. 7-12. 28 ///

The hearing on Defendants' motion was noticed for January 27, 2014. Plaintiff's opposition was therefore due by January 3, 2014. As of the date of this Order, Plaintiff has not filed an opposition or any other filing that could be construed as a request for a continuance. Accordingly, the court deems Plaintiff's failure to oppose as consent to granting the motion to dismiss, and GRANTS the motion.

In light of this Order, Defendants's Motion to Strike Portions of Complaint (Dkt No. 12) is vacated as moot.
