the Honorable George H. King, Chief United States District Judge,
Roybal Federal Building and United States Courthouse, 255 E. Temple
Street, Courtroom 650, Los Angeles, California, to show cause, if
there be any, why Respondents should not be held in civil contempt
for violations of this Court's December 16, 2013 Order in
accordance with the Application filed by the SEC herein. Individual
Respondents are ordered to appear in person at the above time and
place. If they fail to appear in person, a warrant for their arrest
will be issued at that time.
