Hunter v. Philip Morris USA, 582 F.3d 1039, 1042-1043 (9th Cir. 2009).

Defendant is notified and warned that any subsequent attempts to remove the underlying state unlawful detainer action to this Court will be improper and will constitute vexatious conduct for which the Court may impose sanctions, which may include designating defendant as a vexatious litigant and barring him or her from commencing any further removal actions with respect to the underlying state unlawful detainer action.

Accordingly, this matter is **remanded** to the Superior Court of California for the County of Los Angeles for lack of subject matter jurisdiction pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1447(c). The Clerk is directed to send a certified copy of this order to the state court and to serve copies of this order on the parties.
