This matter is before the Court on its own motion. On December 22, 2014, Defendants DreamWorks Animation SKG, Inc. ("DreamWorks"), Lewis W. Coleman, and Jeffrey Katzenberg's (collectively, "Defendants") filed a Motion to Dismiss ("Motion"). On April 1, 2015, the Court issued an order granting the Motion with a fifteen-day leave to amend.
