On August 4, 2014, the Court received a Notice of Appeal from Bankruptcy Court in the matter of In re: Sumaira Rahman. (Doc. No. 1.) Appellants Sumaira Rahman and Syed Rahman, in pro per, appealed an order of the United States Bankruptcy Court, Central District of California, dismissing with prejudice the first through tenth causes of action of a complaint filed by Appellants in an adversary proceeding against Appellees Capital One,


1 N.A. and Mortgage Electronic Registration System. (Doc.
2 No. 2.)

3 On August 12, 2013, the Clerk issued a notice of
4 document discrepancy, stating Appellants failed to pay
5 the filing fees required under 28 U.S.C. §§ 1930 (b) and
6 (c). (Doc. No. 5.) On August 20, 2014, the Court issued
7 an order to show cause, ordering Appellants to correct
8 the discrepancy by August 29, 2014. (Doc. No. 7.) The
9 Court noted that, "Failure to respond to this Order or to
10 correct the deficiency shall result in the dismissal of
11 the appeal." (Id.)

12 As of the date of this Judgment, Appellants have not
13 responded to the Order to Show Cause, nor have they
14 corrected the discrepancy.

15 Accordingly, the Court DISMISSES the Appeal WITHOUT
16 PREJUDICE. The Court orders that such judgment be
17 entered. The Clerk shall close the file.
