 24 class representative enhancement. In light of the documented evidence submitted  
 25 in the moving papers and good cause appearing therefor, the Court hereby grants

**[PROPOSED] ORDER ON PLAINTIFFS' MOTION FOR ATTORNEY'S FEES, COSTS  
 AND CLASS REPRESENTATIVE ENHANCEMENT**

1 the requests for (1) payment of fees in the amount of \$166,666.66 (one third of the  
2 non-reversionary gross settlement amount), (2) reimbursement of the \$11,588.48 in  
3 expenses incurred in the litigation of this matter, as well as (3) a \$7500  
4 enhancement award for the named plaintiff, Cassie Stroup. Plaintiff Class  
5 Counsel's fee rate of \$750 per hour is reasonable and consistent with the  
6 compensation provided to similar attorneys performing the type of work performed  
7 Class Counsel herein. Moreover, Class Counsel's lodestar of \$195,000 exceeds  
8 the fee request and does not include a request for payment for additional time  
9 necessarily to be incurred in the conclusion of the administration of the settlement  
10 herein. The Court further finds that the \$11,728.48 in claimed expenses were  
11 reasonably incurred in the furtherance of the litigation herein and should be paid in  
12 reimbursement to Class Counsel. Finally, the \$7500 Class Representative  
13 enhancement is justified based upon the work performed by Plaintiff Cassie Stroup  
14 for the benefit of the class she has represented, which work was personally  
15 observed to have exceeded 100 hours. The foregoing sums shall be paid in  
16 conformity with the settlement agreement approved concurrently herewith.
