1 Defendant Alton James Washington (“Defendant”) having failed to answer
2 or otherwise respond to the Complaint in this action and his default having been
3 duly entered by the Clerk, NOW, upon the Motion of Trustees of the Southern
4 California IBEW-NECA Pension Plan, Trustees of the Southern California IBEW-
5 NECA Health Trust Fund, Trustees of the Los Angeles County Electrical
6 Educational and Training Trust Fund, Trustees of the National Electrical Benefit
7 Fund, Trustees of the Southern California IBEW-NECA Supplemental
8 Unemployment Benefit Trust Fund, Trustees of the Southern California IBEW-
9 NECA Labor-Management Cooperation Committee, Trustees of the National
10 IBEW-NECA Labor-Management Committee, Contract Compliance Fund, and
11 Los Angeles Electrical Workers Credit Union (“Plaintiffs”) and good cause
12 appearing therefore,

14 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED** that
15 Plaintiffs shall have, and the Clerk is hereby ordered to enter, the following
16 JUDGMENT against Defendant:

- 17 1. Judgment in favor of the Plaintiffs in the sum of **\$18,584.09** for unpaid
18 fringe benefit contributions, prejudgment interest, and liquidated
19 damages;
- 20 2. For auditing costs in the sum of **\$1,237.50**;
- 21 3. For legal costs in the sum of **\$495.00**;
- 22 4. For attorney’s fees in the sum of **\$3,578.60**; and
- 23 5. For post-judgment interest at the statutory rate.
