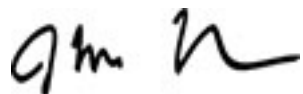
1 The Parties reached a settlement subject to Court approval as represented in  
2 the Settlement Agreement that was filed previously with this Court. This Court  
3 conducted a final approval hearing pursuant to this Court’s Order re Plaintiffs’  
4 Unopposed Motion for Preliminary Approval of Class Action Settlement (the  
5 “Preliminary Approval Order” (Dkt. 193)) and granted Plaintiffs’ Motion for Final  
6 Approval of Class Action Settlement Judgment and Motion for Attorneys’ Fees  
7 and Costs and Service Awards (the “Final Approval Order” (Dkt. 288)). In  
8 accordance with the Final Approval Order and this Court’s Order re Final  
9 Approval Order and Stipulation Regarding Attorneys’ Fees and Costs, Objections,  
10 and Agreement Forgoing Appeal (Dkt. 315),

11 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED:**

- 12 1. Judgment in this matter is entered in accordance with the Settlement  
13 Agreement.
- 14 2. The stay of the Final Approval Order is lifted.
- 15 3. The parties shall effect the Settlement Agreement according to its terms  
16 and according to the terms of the prior orders.
- 17 4. Without affecting the finality of the Judgment, the Court shall retain  
18 exclusive and continuing jurisdiction over this action and the parties,  
19 including all Class Members, for purposes of enforcing the terms of the  
20 Judgment.
