1 **[PROPOSED] ORDER:**


2 Having reviewed the stipulation of the parties to dismiss certain defendants
3 and claims from the action and finding good cause thereon,

4 IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 5 1. All causes of action in Star's Second Amended Complaint against
6 Defendant Leonard A. Feinberg, Inc., Defendant M and Sons, Inc.
7 d/b/a LA Class, Defendant Beyond the Rack USA Inc., and Defendant
8 Rainbow USA, Inc. (incorrectly sued herein as "Rainbow USA, Inc., a
9 New York corporation, individually and d/b/a '579'") are dismissed,
10 *without* prejudice.
11 2. This dismissal *without* prejudice may be converted to a dismissal *with*
12 prejudice at a later date.
