3 Continue Hearing on Order to Show Cause, and good cause appearing therefor,
4 hereby orders as follows:

5 1. The hearing on the Court's September 30, 2014 Order To Show Cause
6 Why A Preliminary Injunction Should Not Be Granted is continued to November 10,
7 2014 at 10:00 a.m.

8 2. Defendants' and Relief Defendants' declarations, affidavits, points and
9 authorities, or other submissions in opposition to the issuance of such an Order shall
10 be filed with the Court on or by October 28, 2014.


11 3. The SEC's reply papers in support of the issuance of such an Order shall
12 be filed with the Court on or by November 3, 2014.

13 4. Defendants and Relief Defendants shall comply with the financial
14 accounting requirement set forth in Section X, pp. 7-8 of the September 30, 2014
15 Temporary Restraining Order on or by October 29, 2014.

16 5. The September 30, 2014 Temporary Restraining Order is hereby
17 extended by the Court, based on Defendants' and Relief Defendants' consent to said
18 extension and in accordance with Fed. R. Civ. P. 65(b)(2), and shall now expire at
19 1:00 p.m. on November 10, 2014, unless for good cause shown it is extended or the
20 parties against whom it is directed consent that it may be extended for a longer
21 period.
