1 TO ALL PARTIES AND THEIR ATTORNEYS OF RECORD:
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3 Based on the Petition to Approve Compromise of Minors B.U. and L.V. filed on
4 December 9, 2016 (Docket No. 128), the *Amended* Petition to Approve Compromise of
5 Minors B.U. and L.V. filed on February 6, 2017 (Docket No. 131), and this Court's
6 Order thereon entered on March 6, 2017 (Docket No. 133), and *GOOD CAUSE*
7 appearing, this Honorable Court enters the following Judgment:

- 8 1) The total amount of the settlement totaling \$999,999.00 shall be paid by the
9 Defendants to the Law Offices of Vincent W. Davis & Associates Client Trust
10 Account;
- 11 2) The costs advanced by Plaintiffs' counsel in the amount of \$25,109.98 shall
12 be deducted and apportioned to Plaintiffs' counsel as reimbursement before
13 division of the remaining corpus among the Plaintiffs;
- 14 3) The remaining corpus of \$974,889.02 shall be divided into equal one-third
15 shares of \$324,963.00, one portion for each Plaintiff (1) Lisa Castillo, (2)

- 9) Lisa Castillo, as trustee of the above minors' trust, swears and affirms that she will abide by the fiduciary obligation to act in her daughters' best interest in serving as trustee for said trust and making distributions to them thereunder.
