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19	Removing Defendant Cardinal Health is ordered to show cause why
20	this action should not be remanded to state court for lack of
21	subject matter jurisdiction. Defendant removed this action to this
22	court on the basis of diversity jurisdiction. District courts have
23	original jurisdiction over "all civil actions where the matter in
24	controversy exceeds the sum or value of \$75,000, exclusive of
25	interest and costs, and is between citizens of different States."
26	28 U.S.C. § 1332(a).
27	It is not clear to the court that the amount in controversy in
28	this matter exceeds \$75,000. Defendant contends that Plaintiff

1 seeks damages in excess of the jurisdictional requirement of 2 \$75,000, notwithstanding the fact that the Complaint does not 3 specify the dollar amount of damages being sought. (Notice of 4 Removal p.6).

5 Accordingly, the court orders Defendant to file a brief, not 6 to exceed five pages, within 10 days of the date of this order, 7 showing cause why this action should not be remanded for lack of 8 jurisdiction. Defendant should also deliver a courtesy copy to 9 chambers, Room 244-J, Second Floor, 312 N. Spring Street, Los 10 Angeles. The court will regard any failure to file an explanatory 11 brief as consent to remand this matter.

12 IN ADDITION, the SCHEDULING CONFERENCE set for January 12,
13 2015 is continued to February 9, 2015 at 3:30 p.m.
