United States District Judge, at 11:00 a.m., on March 30, 2015, and 1 2 show cause why a preliminary injunction should not be issued against enforcement of an unwritten policy or rule that restricts 3 prohibits the sale of religious literature, and the solicitation of 4 donations in conjunction with the distribution of religious 5 literature, as well as the sale of message-bearing T-shirts and 6 7 other merchandise, on the public walkways and plaza areas of the Griffith Observatory, outside of a certain designated area adjacent 8 9 to East Observatory Road.

Defendants are ordered to serve and file any papers in opposition to the issuance of a preliminary injunction no later than March 16, 2015. A memorandum in opposition shall be no more than 25 pages in length and shall conform to Local Rule 11-3.

Plaintiff is further ordered to serve and file any reply papers in support of issuance of the preliminary injunction no later than March 23, 2015. A memorandum in reply shall be no more than 20 pages in length and shall conform to Local Rule 11-3. IT IS SO ORDERED.
