KENNARD J. SHILOH, 13 Defendant. 14 15 The Court will remand this action to state court summarily because defendant 16 removed it improperly. 17 On March 19, 2015, defendant Kennard J. Shiloh, having suffered a judgement in 18 what appears to be a routine Small Claims Court action in California state court (Los 19 Angeles Superior Court Case No. 13G05350), filed a Notice of Removal of that action to 20 this Court and also presented an application to proceed in forma pauperis. 21 The Court has denied the in forma pauperis application under separate cover 22 because the Court lacks jurisdiction over the action. To prevent the action from 23 remaining in jurisdictional limbo, the Court issues this Order to remand the action to 24 state court. 25 Simply stated, as the Court has previously determined, plaintiff could not have 26

brought this action in federal court in the first place, in that defendant does not

competently allege facts supplying either diversity or federal-question jurisdiction, and

therefore removal is improper. 28 U.S.C. § 1441(a); see Exxon Mobil Corp v. Allapattah 1 Svcs., Inc., 545 U.S. 546, 563, 125 S. Ct. 2611, 162 L. Ed. 2d 502 (2005). Even if 2 complete diversity of citizenship existed, the amount in controversy does not exceed the 3 diversity-jurisdiction threshold of \$75,000. See 28 U.S.C. §§ 1332, 1441(b). On the 4 contrary, the complaint in the action sought only \$3,700. 5 Nor does plaintiff's action raise any federal legal question. See 28 U.S.C. §§ 1331, 6 1441(b). 7 Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that (1) this matter be REMANDED to the Superior 8 Court of California, County of Los Angeles, Alhambra Courthouse, 150 West 9 Commonwealth Avenue, Alhambra, California 91801 for lack of subject matter 10 jurisdiction pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1447(c); (2) that the Clerk send a certified copy of 11 this Order to the state court; and (3) that the Clerk serve copies of this Order on the 12 parties. 13 IT IS SO ORDERED. 14 15 MAR 3.1 2015 DATED: 16 OHN F.
