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The Court has reviewed Plaintiff's Third Amended Complaint filed on May 31, 2016.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. The Clerk of the Court is directed to provide Plaintiff with the appropriate number of USM-285 Forms ("Process Receipt and Return"), copies of the summons and the Order Directing Service, and a form Notice of Submission. The Clerk of the Court will keep the original summons for forwarding to the United States Marshal, along with copies of the Third Amended Complaint filed on May 31, 2016.

1           2.    In order to accomplish service of process by the United  
2 States Marshal, Plaintiff must complete these USM-285 forms and send  
3 them to Alma Felix, Clerk to Magistrate Judge Sagar, no later than  
4 **August 1, 2016.**    Plaintiff must also complete the Notice of  
5 Submission to confirm that he has complied with the Court's Order and  
6 include it with the completed USM-285 forms.    Upon receipt of the  
7 completed USM-285 forms and Notice of Submission, the Clerk of the  
8 Court will send the necessary documents to the United States Marshal  
9 for service of process and will file the Notice of Submission.

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11           3.    The completed USM-285 forms must be signed and legible,  
12 written in ink or typed.    Only a Defendant named in the Court's Order  
13 Directing Service of Process can be included on a USM-285 form.    Only  
14 one Defendant can be named on each USM-285 form.    Plaintiff must  
15 provide a first and last name for each Defendant, as well as the  
16 Defendant's identification number, if available.    Plaintiff must  
17 provide a complete street address where each Defendant can be served,  
18 together with any special instructions or other information that may  
19 assist in expediting service, such as whether the Defendant works in  
20 a specific part of the building or whether the Defendant works an  
21 evening shift.    A post office box number is not acceptable.  
22 Plaintiff must sign each USM-285 form.

24           4.    Plaintiff must specify on the USM-285 form whether the  
25 Defendant is being served as an individual or in his/her official  
26 capacity, or both, as indicated on the Order Directing Service of  
27 Process.    If the Defendant is being served in his/her official  
28 capacity, or both his/her individual and official capacities,
