On January 27, 2017, this Court entered an order (Docket No. 50) ("Order") 1 in the captioned action ("Coverage Action") granting defendant and counterclaimant Carolina Casualty Insurance Company's Motion for Summary 3 Judgment (Docket No. 25) in its entirety, and denying plaintiff and counter-4 defendant Phase II Transportation, Inc.'s ("Phase II") Motion for Summary 5 Judgment (Docket No. 26) in its entirety. 6 For the reasons set forth in the Order, there are no triable issues as to any 7 material facts and CCIC is entitled to judgment against Phase II as a matter of law as to all claims for relief asserted in Phase II's complaint against CCIC (Docket No. 1) ("Phase II Complaint") and as to all claims for relief asserted in CCIC's 10 counterclaim against Phase II (Docket No. 22) ("CCIC Counterclaim"). 11 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED as follows: 12 Judgment shall be and hereby is entered in favor of defendant CCIC 13 against plaintiff Phase II as to all claims for relief in the Phase II Complaint, Phase 14 II shall take nothing pursuant to any of the claims in the Phase II Complaint and the 15 Phase II Complaint is dismissed with prejudice in its entirety. 16 2.
