A Peremptory Writ of Mandate shall issue under seal of this Court, ordering the City to set aside its decision in connection with Verizon Wireless' wireless service facilities proposed to be located at 5860 Whitsett Avenue, Los Angeles, California, Case No. ZA-2014-1239-CUW; ENV-2014-1240-MND, and remanding the matter to the South Valley Area Planning Commission for a further administrative hearing in connection with Verizon Wireless' project;
- 2. Within seven (7) court days after the Court's entry of this Stipulated Judgment and issuance of the related Writ of Mandate, Verizon Wireless shall file with the Court a Request for Dismissal, without prejudice, of the First through Third Causes of Action in the Petition and Complaint; and
  - 3. The Parties shall bear their own costs and fees.
