Stipulated Judgment

1           WHEREAS On March 10, 2016, Plaintiff/Petitioner Los Angeles  
2 SMSA Limited Partnership dba Verizon Wireless ("Verizon Wireless") filed  
3 against Defendant/Respondent City of Los Angeles ("City") a Complaint for  
4 Declaratory Judgment, Injunction, and Writ of Mandate; (the "Petition and  
5 Complaint"); and

6           WHEREAS contemporaneous with the filing of this [Proposed] Judgment,  
7 the Parties have executed and filed a Stipulation for Entry of Judgment and  
8 Issuance of Writ of Mandate providing for the entry of this [Proposed] Judgment;

10           THE COURT DOES HEREBY ORDER, ADJUDGE AND DECREE, as  
11 follows:

12           1. Judgment is entered on the Fourth Cause of Action alleged in the  
13 Petition and Complaint. A Peremptory Writ of Mandate shall issue under seal of  
14 this Court, ordering the City to set aside its decision in connection with Verizon  
15 Wireless' wireless service facilities proposed to be located at 5860 Whitsett  
16 Avenue, Los Angeles, California, Case No. ZA-2014-1239-CUW; ENV-2014-  
17 1240-MND, and remanding the matter to the South Valley Area Planning  
18 Commission for a further administrative hearing in connection with Verizon  
19 Wireless' project;

20           2. Within seven (7) court days after the Court's entry of this Stipulated  
21 Judgment and issuance of the related Writ of Mandate, Verizon Wireless shall file  
22 with the Court a Request for Dismissal, without prejudice, of the First through  
23 Third Causes of Action in the Petition and Complaint; and

24           3. The Parties shall bear their own costs and fees.
