7 1. The Joint Pretrial Order is APPROVED;

8 2. The Court will not rule on the plaintiff's pending motion for summary
9 judgment due to the fact that the Court could only make proposed findings of fact and
10 conclusions of law for the United States District Court to finally decide, and it is
11 therefore more appropriate for the District Court to decide the summary judgment
12 motion in the first instance; and

13 3. The adversary proceeding is TRANSFERRED back to the United States
14 District Court for the Central District of California as Case No. 2:16-cv-01903- SJO for
15 all further proceedings.
