12 general ledgers, worker compensation insurance reports, financial statements, cash
13 disbursements ledgers, corporate income tax returns, employee time cards, payroll
14 journals, individual earnings records of all employees, forms W-2, 1099 and 1096
15 submitted to the U.S. Government, quarterly state tax returns, health and welfare
16 and pension report for all other trades, cash receipts' journal, copies of all contracts
17 and all material invoices.

18 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that DEFENDANTS shall pay attorney's fees
19 in the amount of \$540.00 and costs pursuant to the Bill of Costs.
